Americans spend millions of dollars on routine legal needs, from incorporations to trademarks. Others put off creating essential legal documents because of the inconvenience and high fees.

### Incorporations

A business that is legally completely separate from its owners. Most [publicly-traded](#) companies (and all major ones) fall under this classification. For United States tax purposes, corporations, legally known as [C corporations](#), are required to pay [income taxes](#) on their [profits](#). The advantage to a corporate structure is the fact that, unlike other structures, there is no limit to the number of shareholders. A disadvantage is the fact that, because a corporation is taxed by itself and its individual [shareholders](#) are taxed on [dividends](#), it is subject to double taxation. It is important to note that the term corporation almost never refers to an [S corporation](#), which is not entirely separate from its owners.

### Limited Liability Companies

Is a legal form of business organization with daily activities like a partnership but with limited liability similar to a corporation. An LLC is formed in the state in which it operates. An LLC is [formed by filing Articles of Organization](#) with the state in which you will be doing business. (A few states use a [Certificate of Organization](#) to form an LLC.)

### Incorporation for Nonprofit

An incorporated organization which exists for educational or charitable reasons, and from which its shareholders or trustees do not benefit financially. Any money earned must be retained by the organization, and used for its own expenses, operations, and programs. Many non-profit organizations also seek tax exempt status, and may also be exempt from local taxes including sales taxes or property taxes. Well-known non-profit organizations include Habitat for Humanity,

### Charitable Solicitation Licensing

The General Assembly recognizes the right of persons or organizations to conduct solicitation activities. It is the intent of the General Assembly to protect the public by requiring full disclosure by persons who solicit contributions from the public of the purposes for which the contributions are solicited and how the contributions are actually used. It is the intent of the General Assembly to prohibit deception, fraud, and misrepresentation in the solicitation and reporting of contributions.

### Trademark

Given the importance of your company's name and logo, you probably want to make sure no one else can use them. Registering them as a trademark or service mark will help provide that legal protection. A trademark protects the marketing image of the goods you or your company produce. A service mark protects the marketing image of the services you or your company provide to the general public. Both types of mark offer the same degree of legal protection.

*Protect your business/ organization by registering with the proper authorities. There are (3) ways to register your business: (1) Sole Proprietorship (County); (2) Inc., LLC, & NP (State); & (3) United States Patent & Trademark Office (National)*
